This morning, the choir and instrumental ensemble will present Johann Pachelbel's *Magnificat no. 13* (sung in Latin) during our service of Lessons and Carols. Pachelbel was one of the most prolific composers of the late 17th century. He wrote hundreds of pieces for various keyboard instruments, chamber ensembles, choirs and solo voice. Pachelbel served as organist for various entities throughout his career, including St. Stephen's cathedral in Vienna and courts in Eisenach, Erfurt, Stuttgart and Gotha, Germany. In addition to his organ prowess, Pachelbel was highly regarded as a teacher and composer during his lifetime. Enhancing our worship experience this morning is our instrumental ensemble of musicians who teach at James Madison University, Shenandoah Conservatory and Bridgewater College: Jacob Roege and Lianne Campbell, violins; Diane Phoenix-Neal, viola; Ryan Hoffman, cello; Beth Chandler, flute; Jeanette Zyko, oboe and Ryan Romine, bassoon.
