Both of these fine musicians have been woven into the fabric of First Presbyterian Church for many years, not only as musicians, but comprehensively. Their manifold service to our congregation and our community can hardly be overstated! Thank you so much, Jean and Cathy!

A word about the benediction...

About 25 years ago I decided I wanted to be a soloist. At the time I wasn't a very good singer and was positively decimated singing in front of an audience. But I was determined to make it happen. (There's a whole lot more to that story, but I won't bore you with the details.) I took my first voice lesson in March 1994, at the ripe old age of 37, with Roger Zimmerman. That man was a miracle worker. One piece I wanted to learn was John Rutter's "Lord Bless You and Keep You", so we worked hard on that. On June 26 of that year, in this sanctuary, my niece Jennifer (who was 12 at the time) and I sang a pretty little duet that Maureen Drumheller had selected for us. And I sang the benediction. It was one of Jen's earliest public music offerings (and she was wonderful!) and my first significant soprano solo. My parents were still living in New Jersey. Phil Tipton was good enough to make a couple of copies of the service tape so I could send one to them. My mom just loved it and listened to it often. She and Dad moved here in May 2005 and Mom passed away two months later. There was a funeral here, and then a memorial service at their church in NJ a few weeks later. Dad knew that Mom would love to hear that benediction again, so I gathered kids, daughters-in-law, and grandkids in a double quartet and we sang her to Heaven. It's a very special piece to me and I'm happy to share it with you this morning. -Jean Hashagen
