*AFFIRMATION OF FAITH: *Adapted from The PC(USA) Book of Order [W-2.3000]*

Baptism is the sign and seal of incorporation into Christ. Through baptism, Jesus identified with sinners to fulfill all righteousness. Disciples were empowered by the Spirit to undertake a life of service and to be an inclusive worshiping community, in which love, justice, and mercy abounded. In Baptism, we participate in Jesus' death and resurrection; we die to what separates us from God and are raised to newness of life in Christ.

The body of Christ is one, and Baptism is the bond of unity in Christ. Baptism unites the people of God with each other and with the church of every time and place. Barriers of race, gender, status, and age are to be transcended. Barriers of nationality, history, and practice are to be overcome.
