

## Music Notes for this week.

This week, we celebrate **the Sunday of the Pentecost!** Our service is filled with music inspired by the Holy Spirit.


The text for opening hymn, *Come Down, O Love Divine*, comes from a poem written by Bianco da Siena c.1390. The tune, *Down Ampny*, was composed by Ralph Vaughan Williams (1872-1958), inspired by the hundreds of English folk tunes he collected around the turn of the 20<sup>th</sup> century.

Our closing hymn is one of the most familiar hymns from the 1960s, *We Are One In The Spirit*. The words and music were written in 1966 by Peter Scholtes (1938-2009), while he was a Catholic priest serving on the South Side of Chicago. When he could not find a suitable song to accompany a series of ecumenical and interracial events at which his youth choir was to sing, he penned this iconic hymn in just one day.
