

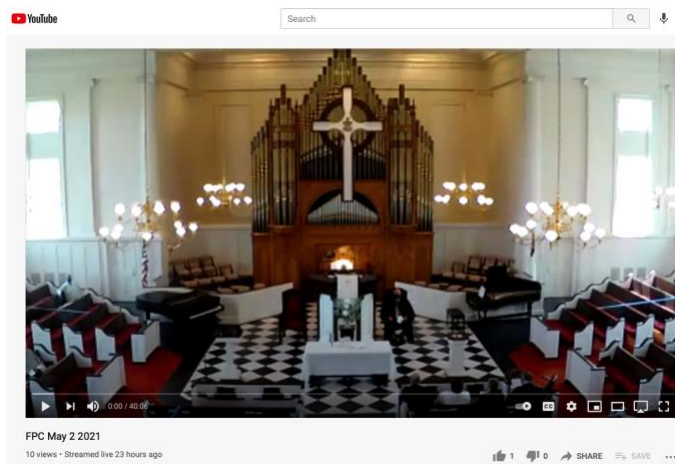

Music Notes for this week.

This Sunday, Terry Crickenberger and Joe Earhart will sing the anthem, *O Lord, Hear My Prayer*. It is one of many hymns from **the Taizé Community**, an ecumenical monastic community founded in Burgundy, France, in 1940. Much of the music was conceived of and composed by Jacques Berthier, informed by various musical traditions, from Eastern Orthodox chants to simple, repeated phrases.
