Why is it so hot in here?



If these air conditioning units were cars, we could register them as *Antiques*. Original to the building, they were installed during the reconstruction in 1983-4. These units have served well over the years, but are far beyond their serviceable lives, and need replaced.

The complicated HVAC layout, coupled with the difficulty of removal and installation, means this is going to be a big project. The Property and Maintenance Committee is seeking proposals, and looking for ways to mitigate the heat until a permanent solution can be implemented.

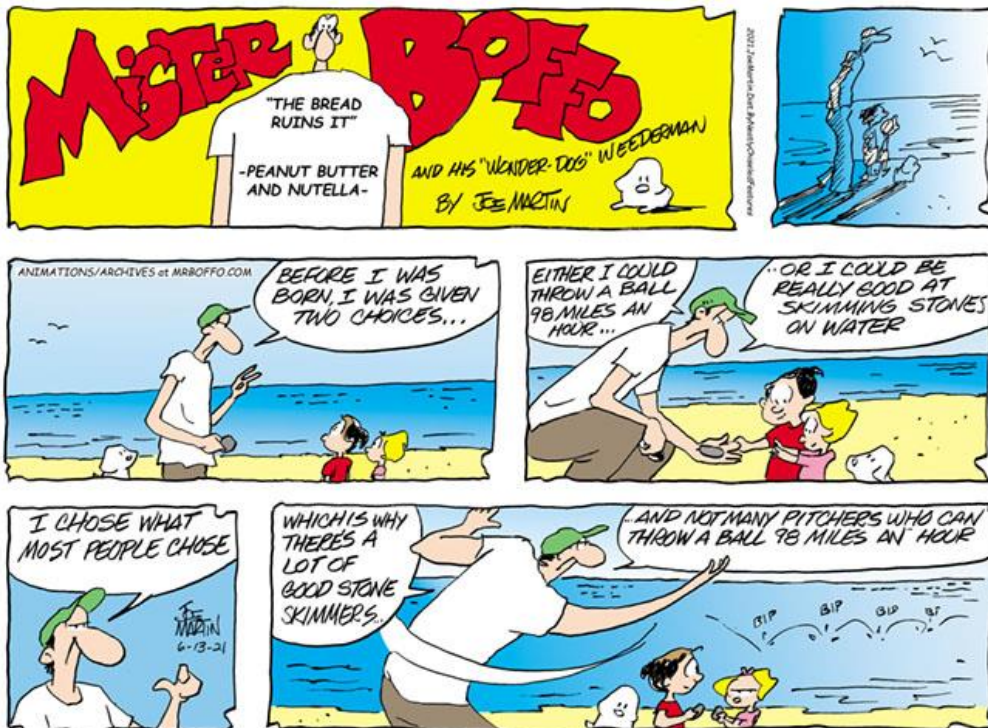

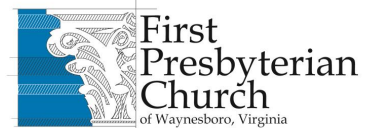
