## Music Notes for this week.

The music for this final Sunday of May celebrates both the **Holy Trinity** and **Memorial Day**.

The opening hymn for the 30<sup>th</sup> will be the very first hymn in the hymnal, *Holy, Holy, Holy*. This stirring hymn will conclude with an arrangement of the hymn that Roger composed twenty years ago.

Soprano **Jean Hashagen** will share her musical gifts this week during the anthem, singing *I, the Lord of Sea and Sky*, also known as *Here I Am, Lord*, by contemporary Roman Catholic songwriter **Dan Schutte**. A founding member of the *St. Louis Jesuits*, Schutte (b. 1947) has published more than 500 compositions, many of them in the folk idiom - a response to the to the liturgical reforms of the Second Vatican Council.

The closing hymn will be *God of the Ages* (also known as *God of Our Fathers*), in honor of those who have made the ultimate sacrifice in service for their country.
